PRODUCER'S | RIGHTS

- Complimentary client support for Canadian Livestock Tracking System (CLTS) data reporting and tag purchasing
- Protection of privacy of all producer data in the CLTS
- Purchase tags, applicators, and accessories from CCIA or Authorized Dealers
- View their own data on request
- Access to no-charge technical support for tagging, reading and reporting traceability data
- Free support for defective CCIA ear tags
- Competitive national price for approved CCIA tags

PRODUCER'S | OBLIGATIONS

- Report tag issues/problems
- Use the proper applicator when applying tags
- Install tags as per manufacturer's instructions
- Keep CLTS contact information and premises data accurate
- Reduce/remove tag snag hazards in areas that livestock frequent
- Apply tags before animals leave the place of custody

CCIA'S | RIGHTS

- Provide regulated data to stakeholders as mandated by Health of Animals Part XV regulations
- Collect current, up-to-date tag/producer data
- Sell and distribute tags, applicators, and accessories
- Refuse information inquiries outside proper channel

CCIA'S | OBLIGATIONS

- Collect regulated tag data as determined by the Health of
- Protect industry and government privacy
- Ensure adequate supplies and access to approved tags
- Ensure accuracy and timeliness of regulated data
- Supply tags that meet minimum national technical standards
- Accept trace data in different modalities, such as the CLTS MOBO APP
